A. City transport in Prague - general information

Metro

The Prague Metro network consists of 3 lines designated by letters and differentiated in colour. Green colour (Depo Hostivar station - Dejvicka station – line A), yellow colour (Cerny most station - Zlicin station – line B), red colour (Ladvi - Haje station – line C), with transfers possible at Museum station (lines A and C), Mustek station (lines A and B), Florenc station (lines B and C). Metro operates daily from 05:00 to 24:00. The time interval between train departures is approximately from 2 to 3 minutes during the workday rush hours and from 4 to 10 minutes during off-peak hours.

Trams

Daytime operation is from 04:30 to 24:00. Night-time operation is from 00:30 to 4:30 and is provided by tram numbers 51 to 58 with traffic intervals 30 minutes.

Buses

The daytime and night-time operation of buses is similar to tram operation. Night-time service is provided by bus numbers 501 to 514.

Prague City Transport Fares

Travelling by city transport is possible only with a valid ticket. Passengers have to obtain their tickets before boarding the vehicle or entering the Metro system. The ticket is valid only if marked in the validation appliance. Tickets can be bought at selected Metro stations or in “Dopravni podnik” Information Centres, hotels, at news stands, travel bureaus, department stores, etc. Single tickets can also be bought from the slot machines located at Metro stations or near some stops of surface transport.

Transfer ticket: 26 CZK

Discounted (children 6 to 15): 13 CZK

- the ticket is valid for 75 minutes after marking

1 day ticket: 100 CZK

Discounted (children 6 to 15) 50 CZK

3 days ticket: 330 CZK

5 days ticket: 500 CZK

Limited transfer ticket: 18 CZK

Discounted (children 6 to 15) 9 CZK

- *For trams and buses:* valid for 20 min. from validation, with no transfer options.
- *For metro:* valid for 5 stations (excl. boarding station; transfer station is counted as a single station). Travel time must not exceed 30 min. after validation.
- *For funicular, ferry and night lines:* not valid for this form of transport.

Transport by taxi

You will find them in front of hotels (more expensive) and at all the important places. You can command the taxi at the reception desk.

The maximum prices for taxi services in the district of the capital city of Prague:

- ride in the district of the capital city of Prague 25-28 CZK / 1 km
- boarding fee 30-40 CZK
- waiting 5 CZK / 1min.

The maximum prices are valid for all the vehicles offering the taxi services in the district of the capital city of Prague. The price for waiting includes waiting in a traffic jam (slow traffic) as well as waiting on customer's request. Fare outside the district of the capital city of Prague is not limited.

The price for the way from Airport to the congress venue should be about 300 CZK (12 Euro).

B. How to reach the congress venue - CULS Campus

The Czech University of Life Sciences is located on the north-western border of Prague, close to the Prague airport and with a very good access to the Prague city centre.

Approach by train

- *Holesovice railway station:* from metro station **Holesovice** (red line - under the train station) to metro station **Museum** – transfer from red line to green line (2 minutes). From metro station **Museum** to metro station **Dejvicka** (terminal station of the green line). Transfer to a bus (Suchdol direction). By bus **107** or **147** from **Dejvicka** to the bus stop **Kamycka** or **Zemedelska univerzita** – depends on your accommodation. Approximate duration of the travel is 35 minutes.
- *Prague Main station:* from metro station **Hlavni nadrazi** (red line - under the train station) to metro station **Museum** – transfer from red line to green line (2 minutes). From metro station **Museum** to metro station **Dejvicka** (terminal station of the green line). Transfer to bus (Suchdol direction). By bus **107** or **147** from **Dejvicka** to bus stop **Kamycka**, **Zemedelska univerzita** or **Internacionalni** – depends on your accommodation. Approximate duration of the travel is 30 minutes.

Approach by bus

Long-distance coach connections tend to be faster, more frequent and marginally cheaper than train connections, and remoter locations require fewer transfers.

- *Florenc bus station:* from metro station **Florenc** (yellow line - close to the bus station) to metro station **Mustek** – transfer from yellow line to green line (2 minutes). From metro station **Mustek** to metro station **Dejvicka** (terminal station of the green line). Transfer to bus (Suchdol direction). By bus **107** or **147** from **Dejvicka** to bus stop **Kamycka** or **Zemedelska univerzita** – depends on your accommodation. Approximate duration of the travel is 30 minutes.

Approach by plain

The Prague Airport is located approximately 10 km away from the city centre and 5 km from the University Campus. Prague has an international connection with all the main cities of Europe and other continents.

NOTE: Due to a low interest of participants the transport from the Prague airport to the congress venue will not be provided. Please use the city transport or taxi according the travel information.

- *Prague Airport Ruzyně:* take bus **119** from bus stop **Letiste Ruzyne** to bus stop **Dejvicka**. Transfer to bus stop in Suchdol direction (2 minutes). By bus **107** or **147** from **Dejvicka** to bus stop **Kamycka** or **Zemedelska univerzita** – depends on your accommodation. Approximate duration of the travel is 40 minutes.

Approach by car

The GPS coordinate of the CULS Campus: **50°7'48.078"N, 14°22'25.28"E**

- *Arrival from west:* at the Prague bypass use the exit 28 (Ruzyne) then continue in direction to **Horomerice** and from there in direction to Prague via the streets of Velvarska, Uneticka, Suchdolska, Kamycka.
- *Arrival from south and east:* through the city centre to city district **Dejvice**. From Vitezne namesti via the streets of Jugoslavskych partyzanu, Podbabska, Roztocka, Kamycka.

C. Transport to and from the CULS Campus

The Campus (bus stop Kamycka – 5 minutes from the Campus, Zemedelska univerzita – 3 minutes from the Campus) could be in the daytime reached by buses No. **107** and **147** from the bus stop Dejvická (terminal station of metro line A – green). The interval between departures is approximately from 5 to 10 minutes. In the night time the Campus can be reached by bus No. **502**. The interval between departures is about 1 hour. Information about timetables is available at the Congress bureau, at bus stops or at internet.

D. Information about transport to the hotels

- Hotel Pension JaS: Take the bus (Suchdol direction).
By bus **107, 147, Kamycka** stop
- Hotel Elio Garni: Take the bus (Suchdol direction).
By bus **107, 147, Kamycka** stop
- Student's dormitories: Take the bus (Suchdol direction).
By bus **107, 147, Kamycka** or **Zemedelska univerzita**
- CULS campus Hostel: Take the bus (Suchdol direction).
By bus **107, 147 Zemedelska univerzita**
- Hotel Galaxie: Take the bus (Suchdol direction).
By bus **107, 147 Internacionalni**
- Crowne Plaza Prague Hotel: Take the bus (Suchdol direction).
By bus **107, 147, 116, 160, 355, 359** from **Dejvicka** to bus stop **Podbaba**
(the first stop)
